# **ENDORSEMENT APPLICATION for 2022 SEASON**

KY Farm Share Coalition (KYFSC) is a community supported agriculture program (CSA) designed to connect farms with employer partners to offer workplace wellness CSA programs with a mission to help farmers increase and stabilize their annual revenue while improving healthy food access. The program is operated by the Organic Association of Kentucky and is made possible by many partnerships.

KYFSC endorsed farms may participate in workplace CSA incentive programs and other CSA marketing campaigns facilitated by the program. Additionally, farmers from endorsed farms have the opportunity to participate in group discussions, workshops, trainings and research hosted or facilitated by the program. Interest in CSA is growing and KYFSC is seeking new farms to join the coalition and expand the program.

## **Farm Application Process**

- Complete application contained in this document and through the google form link on page 3 below and submit all required documents to kyfarmshare@oak-ky.org by **December 3, 2021**.
- Applications are reviewed with final decisions made by December 21, 2021 for the 2022 season.
- Previously endorsed farms need to complete the application each year to update information.
- The CSA Farm Endorsement Committee (comprised of 2 KYFSC farmers, 1 OAK staff and 1 OAK
  Organic Transition Trainer) will review your application and set up a brief conference call with you to
  discuss your CSA, explain how the program works, and answer any questions.
- The Farm Endorsement Committee will schedule a farm visit with you.
- The Farm Endorsement Committee will then make a recommendation to the Advisory Committee about formal endorsement of your farm.
- Farms are notified of decisions by December 21, 2021.

#### Core Characteristics of KYFSC Endorsed Farms

- Demonstrate past and current success in growing produce CSA;
- Have a minimum of 3 years of experience growing produce for CSA;
- Grow 100% of farm share produce on the applicant farm (no vegetable or fruit aggregation for shares);
- Offer CSA shares during the main growing season for a minimum of 20 weeks;
- Be USDA certified organic for crop or in active and documented organic transition;
- Follow relevant food safety regulations;
- Deliver informative and regular communication to CSA members;
- Have a commitment to the coalition including shared farmer-to-farmer learning, collaborative CSA market expansion through the project and advancing organic practices

## Benefits to the Farm/Farmer when joining KY Farm Share Coalition

- Project elevates CSA model across the state and directs the public to Coalition Endorsed farms through website, maps, project literature, CSA Fairs, marketing and social media.
- Access to workplace CSA programs through employers that offer incentivized CSA programs.
- Improve CSA member retention through workplace programs and gain access to new CSA members.
- KYFSC offers employer participants access to supplementary resources and culinary programming to make the season engaging and successful for new and returning CSA customers.
- Take advantage of annual farmer-to-farmer discussions about CSA production and marketing and related trainings as developed by the Coalition.
- Benefit from a local and national network of partner relationships focused on local food, CSA and organic agriculture nurtured by coalition farmer members and OAK/KYFSC staff.

## **Applicable Fees**

- All participating farms select a one-time KYFSC joining fee or select an amount on a sliding scale or exempt status below.
- All CSA shares that move through the program with an incentive are subject to a KYFSC marketing fee
  of \$12 per small/mini CSA share and \$20 per large/regular or robust/XL CSA share.
- Being a KYFSC Endorsed Farm does not guarantee CSA sales.
- These fees are essential to the long-term sustainability of KYFSC and support CSA marketing and staffing for the program.

## An Important Note about Compliance

If an endorsed farm is not in compliance with any policies in the KY Farm Share Coalition Policy Manual, including any stated deadlines, the Farm Endorsement Committee may take any of the following actions until the farm complies:

- Communicate with the farm and offer assistance in meeting the policy requirements
- Temporarily remove the farm from the project website
- Disallow the farm from participating in KYFSC marketing programs
- Set a final deadline for compliance, after which the farm will no longer be endorsed by the project
